SENDIASS

SENDIASS (Special Educational Needs and Disabilities Information Advice Support Service) is a statutory service and is run by Family Action. It is part of a wider service known as WESAIL (Wakefield Early Support Advice Information Liaison).

The service is a free, impartial and confidential which is independent from the Council. The service is available to children, young people aged 0 to 25 with special educational needs and disabilities (SEND), and their parents and carers.

WESAIL offer

Information, advice and support on a range of matters including education, health and social care including:

- Advice and guidance related to SEND legislation and statutory guidance.
- Unlimited access to our duty support
- Advice before a meeting to help you to prepare and know what you want to say.
- Emailed links to websites that help you to be informed.
- Signposting to services that may be able to help you.
- Advice after a meeting to discuss next steps.
- Further to this, it may be possible to support during a meeting
