What is the Wakefield SEND Local Offer?

The Wakefield SEND Local Offer sets out information about services and support for children and young people aged 0 - 25 with special educational needs and/or disabilities (SEND). It is intended for children and young people, their families, and the practitioners and professionals who support them within the local area.

What kind of information is on the Local Offer?

Education

- information about early years, schools and post 16 settings
- services that support children and young people in education settings
- SEND Support and Education, Health and Care Plans

Health

- physical and mental health support
- community and hospital services
- annual health check

Social care

- assistance with daily living
- short breaks

Things to do

- groups, charities, clubs, SEND sessions

Preparing for Adulthood

- Post 16 and Post 18 education
- routes to employment
- independent living

Support services

- for children and young people
- for families
- for schools and settings
